

# **DATA REVIEW 2019**

## **DEMOGRAPHICS**

- 1. Total Population Minimal changes in both counties from 2010 to 2017; Cedar 18,499 to 18,543; Jones 20,638 to 20,356;
- 2. 0-5 Population Cedar decreased by almost 14% Jones County slight change; Cedar 1352 to 1189 children 0-5 from 2011 to 2017; Jones 1379 to 1368;
- 3. # of Live Births Minimal changes in both counties in past 6 years; some data swings through the years 2011 to 2017; Cedar -- 190 to 188; Jones 190 to 197;

## **HEALTHY CHILDREN**

- 4. % of Eligible Children Receiving WIC Significant decrease in both counties 2007 to 2017; Cedar 14% to 5.7%; Jones 19.1% to 12.3%;
- 5. % of Women Receiving Prenatal Care Steady in Cedar at 84%; Significant increase in Jones 66.9% to 83.8% 2007 to 2017;
- 6. % of Students K-12 w/ Valid Immunization Record Steady in both counties from 07/08 to 17/18 at 99-100%;
- 7. Medicaid Enrolled Children 0-5 Who Received Dental Services Slight changes in both counties 2009 to 2017; Cedar ~ 42%; Jones ~ 61%;
- 8. % Children Born with Low Birth Weights Significant decrease in Cedar, 10.5% to 3.7%; Slight in Jones 8.3% to 7.6% over 9 year span 2007 to 2016;

## CHILDREN READY TO SUCCEED IN SCHOOL

- 9. Children Entering Kindergarten w/ Preschool Experience Slight increase in Cedar 87.9% to 91.2%; significant increase in Jones 43.4% to 88.8%; SY10/11 to SY17/18;
- 10.% of Kindergarteners Proficient in Early Literacy Skills Combined increase in counties by 15 % points; 2014 56% to 71% in 2017;

11.% of 3<sup>rd</sup> Graders Reading at Proficient levels – Cedar County 3 out of 4 reporting districts decreased slightly; -- Jones County 2 out of 4 districts decreased, 1 significantly; SY13/14 to SY17/18;

### SAFE & SUPPORTIVE COMMUNITIES

- 12. Child Poverty Rates Slight to moderate increases in both counties 2007 to 2016; Cedar 8.4% to 9.1%; Jones 11.2% to 13.4%
- 13.Free & Reduced Lunch Rates Moderate to significant increase in both counties SY09/10 to SY17/18; Cedar 23.6% to 25.9%; Jones 34.7% to 40.6%;
- 14. Crime Rates Moderate decline in both counties 2016 to 2016; questionable data;

### SECURE & NURTURING FAMILIES

- 15.# of Founded & Confirmed Child Abuse Cases Slight changes in both counties 2007 to 2017; Cedar 64 to 59; Jones 47 to 50; change in reporting also shows significant # of Family Assessments;
- 16.Domestic Violence Rates Significant increase in Cedar 10.82 to 21.77 rate of incidence per 100,000; Moderate decrease in Jones 112.7 to 88.27; 2015 to 2016;
- 17. Teen Birth Rate Slight decrease in Cedar 3.2% to less than 3.0%; Moderate decrease in Jones 5.2% to 3.0%; 2011 to 2017;

### SECURE & NURTURING EARLY LEARNING ENVIRONMENTS

- 18.DHS Registered Homes Significant decrease in Cedar 19 to 14; Moderate decrease in Jones 19 to 16; 2013 to 2018;
- 19.DHS Licensed Centers Remains steady in both counties; does not include Before and After School; 2013 to 2018;
- 20.QRS Participation QRS 3,4, or 5 significant increase in Cedar; stead in Jones; Point in Time; 2016 to 2018;
