Stop the Transport of Invasive Species:

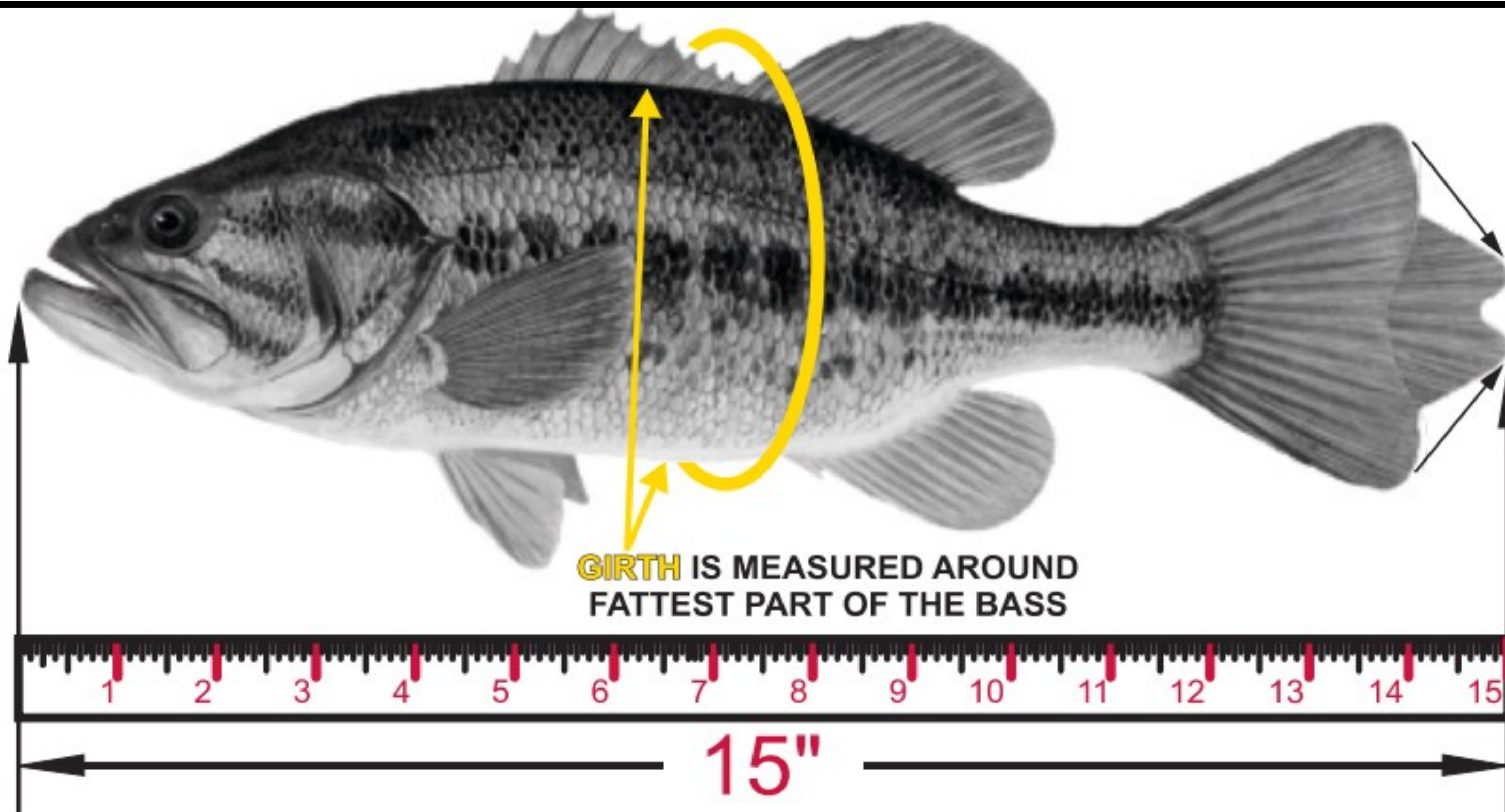
- **CLEAN** boots, gear, boat, trailer & vehicle of plants, fish, animals & mud.

- **DRY** equipment before launching watercraft into another body of water.
