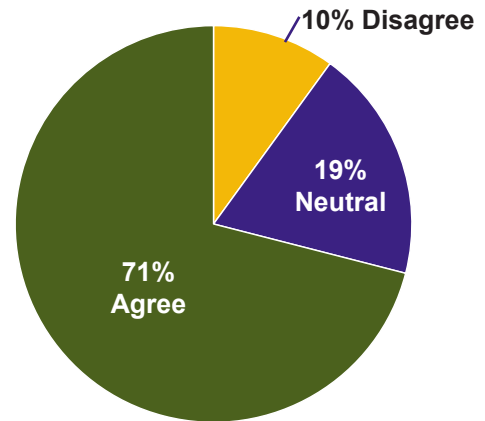


Survey Results - Cabins

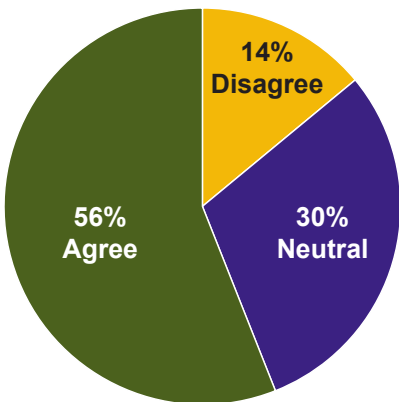
I see a need for rustic, “camping” cabins with only electrical service and no plumbing or restrooms.



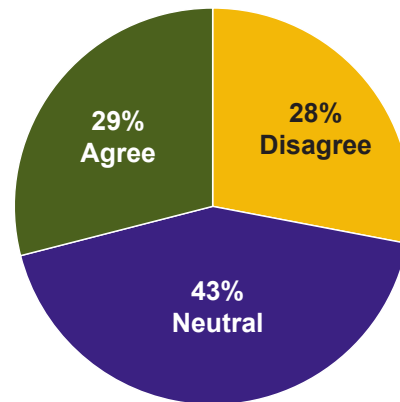
I see a need for a modern cabin with heating, cooling, and restrooms that sleeps 2 - 4 people.



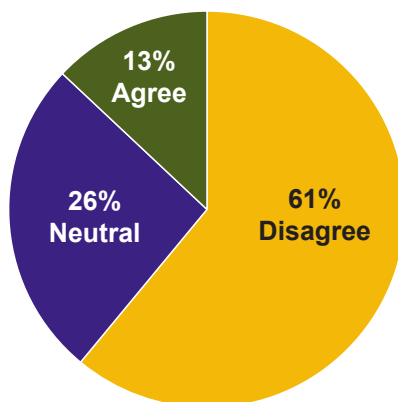
I see a need for a modern cabin with heating, cooling, and restrooms that sleeps 6 - 8 people.



I see a need for a modern cabin with heating, cooling, and restrooms that sleeps 10 - 12 people.

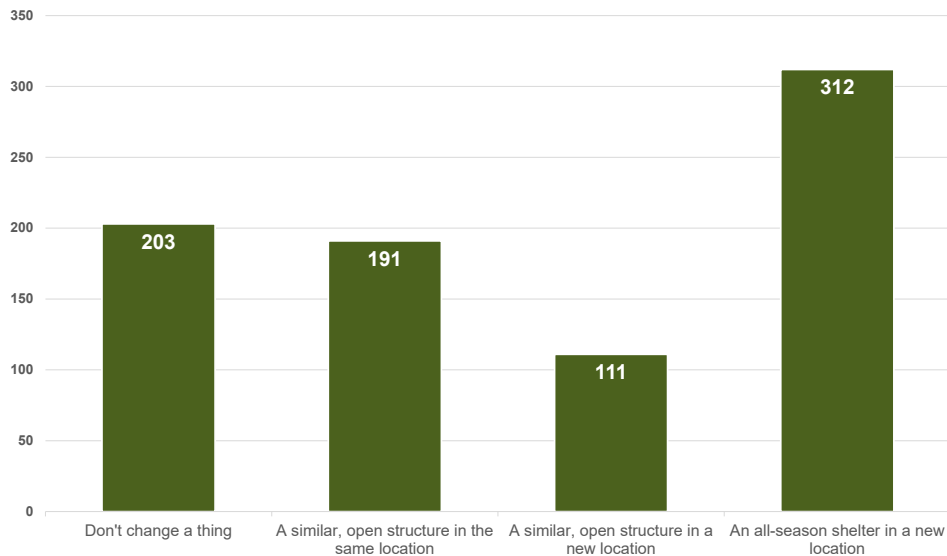

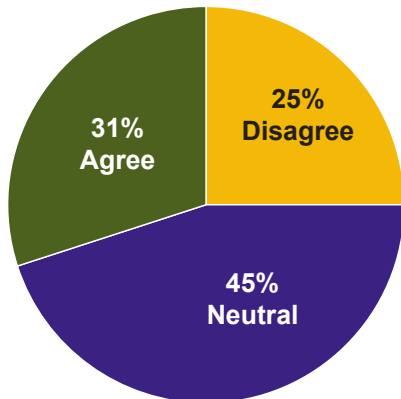

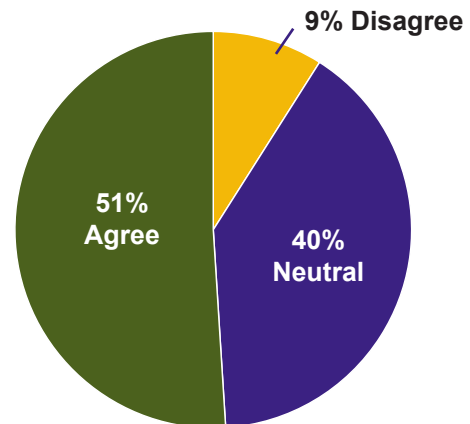
The existing enclosed pavilion between the beach and playground should be updated with:



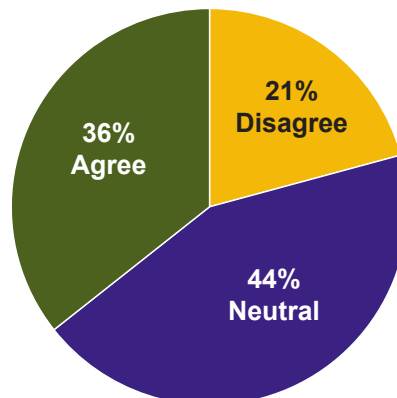
Replace the nature center with a new structure in the same or similar location.

Reuse the existing nature center building for community space/gatherings and find a new location for the nature center building in the park.



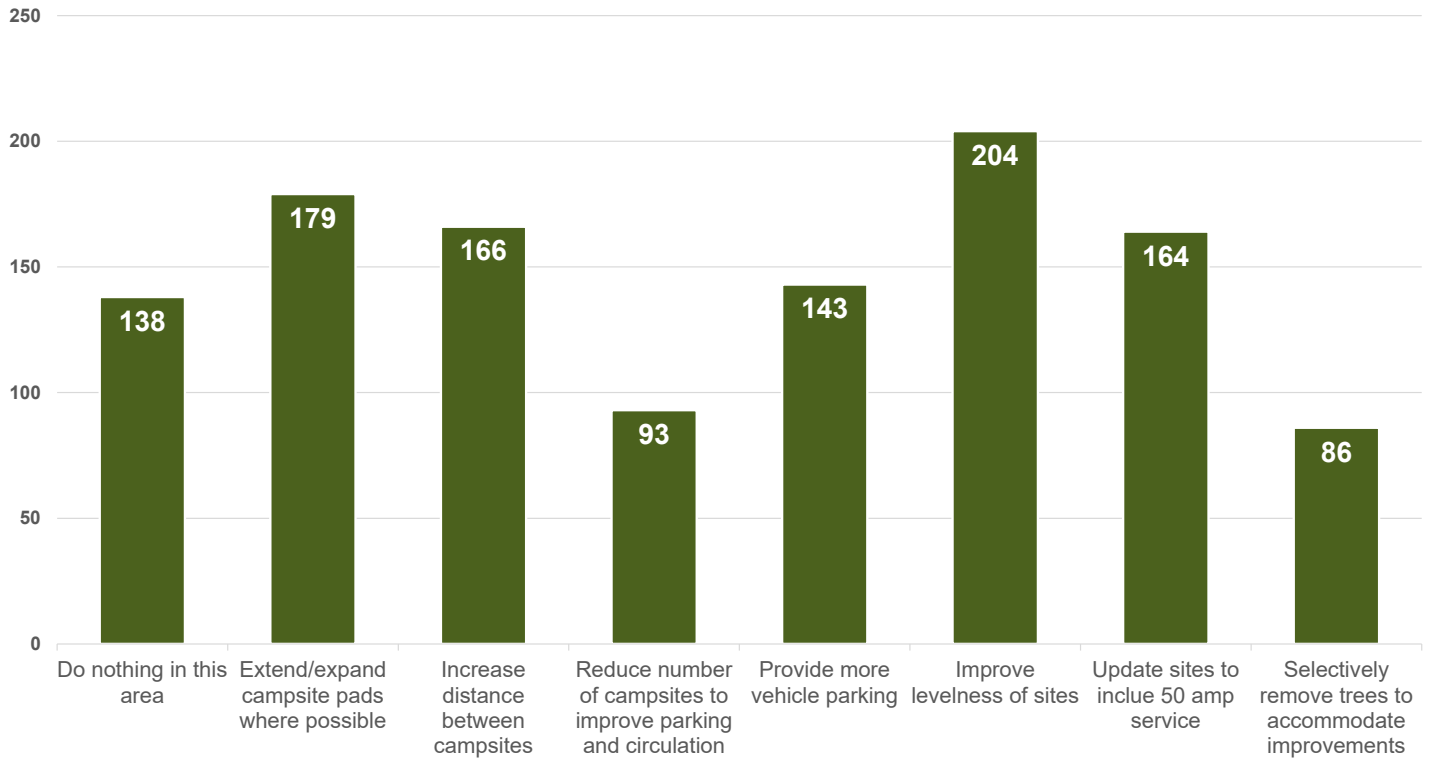
