The bidder hereby certifies that no other principal is involved in or has an interest in this proposal; that the bidder has thoroughly examined the plans and specifications and this contract form and is aware of the provisions contained herein; that the bidder has examined the site of the work and understands that the quantities of work required by the plans and specifications are approximate only and are subject to increases and decreases; that the bidder understands that all quantities of work actually required must be performed; that the bidder proposes to timely furnish the specified material in the quantities required and to furnish the machinery, equipment, labor and expertise necessary to competently complete this project by the time specified; that no state or county official or employee has a direct or indirect interest in the contract which would cause violation of lowa Code Section 314.2; that the bidder has made no agreement with any supplier of motor fuel or special fuel which will result in a violation of lowa Code Section 452A.17(8).

# **Detailed Project Description:**

- 1. Removal and proper off-site disposal of approximately 750 feet of existing fence.
- 2. Cut and remove all trees within 10 feet of existing fence for approximately 510 feet.
  - a. Neatly pile trees in the location pre-determined by Jones County Conservation staff (see attached map for approximate location).
- 3. Cut and move all trees within 10 feet of existing fence for approximately 240 feet. Drop all trees toward Eby's Mill Wildlife Area.
- 4. All stumps shall be flush cut to surface grade.
- 5. Installation of new Type A fence consisting of the following:
  - a. 5 strands of barbed wire. Barbed wire shall be 12-1/2 gauge cables with two-point barbs, the latter spaced four to five inches apart. Spools shall be 80 rod in length weighing approximately 78 pounds per spool. The wire shall be thoroughly annealed and galvanized.
  - b. Fence line posts shall be spaced 12 feet apart maximum, alternating 2 steel and one wooden. Wood posts shall be minimum of 5 inch diameter (Small end).
  - c. Two wooden posts to be utilized to span bottom of drainage.
  - d. Two 12 inch minimum wood posts with brace will be utilized at existing gate location spaced 8 feet apart maximum.
- 6. Precautions will be taken to minimize soil disturbance. Any disturbed areas will be graded level to match pre-project conditions.

# If the bid is accepted:

1. The contractor agrees to provide a current certificate of liability and property damage insurance, and workman's compensation insurance. This certificate will be filed with the Conservation Department prior to the execution of the contract and shall be maintained at such amounts throughout the prosecution of the work and until final acceptance and completion of the contract. The minimum coverage by such insurance shall be as follows:

Public Liability Insurance Per Person \$500,000. Property Damage Insurance Each Occurrence \$500,000.

Each Occurrence \$1,000,000.

Aggregate \$1,000,000.

Workman's Compensation Insurance: In accordance with the laws of the State of Iowa covering all employees who perform any of the obligations under the Agreement.

2. Basis of Payment - The County shall make payment within 60 days of receipt of payment request which is approved as payable by the Department by the following method:

- a. Unit Price Basis: The County shall pay to the contractor the unit price amount stated with respect to each item of work on the attached schedule for the total number of units each item of work completed. The number of units shown on the attached schedule is approximate only, and the final payment shall be made for the actual number of units that are incorporated into or made necessary by the work covered by this contract.
- The contractor agrees to perform all work Monday-Friday between 7 AM and 6 PM unless written permission is provided by the Conservation Department.
- 4. Bidder agrees: to perform all "extra work" required to complete the project at sums to be agreed upon in writing prior to commencement of such "extra work" or if prior agreement cannot be reached, to perform the work on a "force-account basis" as provided in the specifications.




Fence Detail
