CENTRAL PARK FREMONT MILL BRIDGE REHABILITATION PROJECT RESOLUTION

Resolution approving and confirming plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost for the Central Park Fremont Mill Bridge Rehabilitation Project

WHEREAS, the Conservation Board of Jones County, Iowa, has heretofore given preliminary approval to the plans, specifications, form of contract and estimate of cost (the "Contract Documents") for the proposed Central Park Fremont Mill Bridge Rehabilitation Project (the "Project"), as described in the notice of hearing on the Contract Documents for the Project; and

Eby's Mill/Maquoketa River Access Design and Funding Review. Dean made a motion to commit 25% funding to the Maquoketa River/Eby's Mill Bridge Access Project. Seconded by Dave. All ayes. Motion carried.

Central Park Derecho Damage Project Silt Fence Contractor Selection. Dean made a motion to approve \$2.15/foot for silt fence by B&J Hauling. Seconded by Jeff. All ayes. Motion carried.

Grant Wood Trail – Martelle – Bench Replacement and Repair Cost Review; Trail Surface Resealing Bid Review; and Entry Stone Repainting Bid Review. Dave made a motion to approve bids from Outdoor Recreation for \$774 and Pilot Rock for \$1,132 for the bench replacement and repair; the bid from Pate Asphalt Systems for \$4,808 to do the trail surface resealing; and to wait to approve the entry stone repainting as bids have not been received. Seconded by Jeff. All ayes. Motion carried.

Education Event Updates: Education programs were shared with the Board.

Conservation Area and Project Updates: Updates provided on the tree and brush clean up at Central Park, the \$4,206 grant received from the Iowa DNR for replacement trees/shrubs at the Grant Wood Trail Martelle and Central Park, and October 18th is when utilities are shut off in the Central Park campground.
