Moved by Oswald seconded by Zirkelbach to approve, and place on file, the Clerk's Report of Fees Collected for the month ending August 31, 2025. All aye. Motion carried. [2025-156]

Kellie Arduser, Aflac, met with the Board to discuss providing insurance education meetings with county employees.

The Engineer and Assistant to the Engineer met with the Board for a public hearing regarding the Landis Bridge project, to give an update on the County Road X31 paving project, and for an interfund transfer from the Secondary Road fund to the Rural Services fund.

Moved by Oswald seconded by Zirkelbach to open the public hearing at 9:31 a.m. on the Landis Road bridge project on the intent to fund a site-specific project and to acquire property rights for said project. All aye. Motion carried.

The Engineer and Assisitant to the Engineer explained the project, grant funding for the project, the letting process, and changes to the roadway leading up to the bridge. There were fourteen citizens present in-person for the public hearing and numerous participants via ZOOM. Several citizens in the room had concerns about eminent domain, road name changes, and questions about the status of the old bridge being torn out. RESOLUTION TO FUND THE FINAL SITE-SPECIFIC DESIGN AND FOR THE AUTHORITY TO ACQUIRE PROPERTY BY EMINENT DOMAIN FOR THE PUBLIC IMPROVEMENT ON LANDIS ROAD

Whereas, this being the date and time set for a hearing on a proposal to fund the final sitespecific design and for the authority to acquire property by eminent domain for the public improvement on Landis Road; and

Whereas, the Board has held a public hearing declaring the intent to fund the site-specific design, to make the final selection of the route, and to acquire or condemn, if necessary, all or a portion of the property or an interest in the property for the public improvement on Landis Road for a new bridge over the Wapsipinicon River that will be approximately 900 feet downstream on an alternate roadway alignment that will connect with 95th street.
