Resolution to Set a Public Hearing

Whereas, the Jones County Board of Supervisors (Board) will conduct a public hearing under the provisions of Sections 6B.2A and 6B.2B of the Iowa Code for a grading project on Dales Ford Road; and

Whereas, the Board shall discuss whether to fund a site-specific design for the public improvement on a portion of Dales Ford Road in Section nine (9) and Four (4) of Scotch Grove Township; and

Whereas, the public hearing shall be an opportunity for the public to provide input into the decision to fund the site-specific design for the public improvement; and

Whereas, funds for this project are available in the Secondary Road Option Tax Fund; and

Whereas, before Jones County can proceed with said project, the Board must:

1. Hold a public hearing, providing the opportunity for public input on the question of proceeding with the public improvement and on the acquisition or condemnation of property interests for the project; and
2. Adopt a resolution declaring its intent to proceed with said project and authorizing the acquisition of property interests required for the project by negotiation or condemnation.

Now, therefore, be it Resolved, the Board will conduct a public hearing on the intent to fund a site-specific project and to acquire property rights therefore is to be held on Tuesday, February 17, 2026, at 9:30 a.m. in the Boardroom of the Jones County Courthouse, Anamosa, Iowa.

The Board gave brief updates on past and future committee meetings.
