The Jones County Board of Supervisors met in regular session. Present Supervisors Hall, Oswald, Schlarmann, Swisher, and Zirkelbach.

Moved by Zirkelbach seconded by Hall approve the minutes of the July 21, 2026 meeting. All aye. Motion carried.

Moved by Swisher seconded by Schlarmann to approve claims #2607-0189 through #2607-0376. All aye. Motion carried.

The Treasurer met with the Board to present the Semi-Annual and Quarterly Investment Reports for the County and for Solid Waste.

Moved by Swisher seconded by Hall to place on file the Treasurer's Semi- Annual Report for the period of January 1, 2026 through June 30, 2026 and to approve the Quarterly Investment Report for the quarter ending June 30, 2026. All aye. Motion carried. [2026-094; 2026-095]

The Auditor met with the Board on the various motions as noted below and to discuss the potential for a county vehicle usage policy.

Moved by Swisher seconded by Schlarmann to appoint the following individuals to fill vacancies on the Compensation Commission for Eminent Domain: Katie Gombert as a real estate agent, and Zach Borst as an owner – city/town. All aye. Motion carried.

Moved by Hall seconded by Zirkelbach to acknowledge a receipt of a manure management plan from John Sander for a facility located in Section 36 of Hale Township. All aye. Motion carried.

The Land Use Administrator met with the Board to discuss a request from the Planning and Zoning Commission to review the current Cryptocurrency and Data Center Ordinance and to consider revising it to meet large scale data center criteria.

The Assistant to the Engineer met with the Board for approval of a culvert maintenance project contract and to give an update on the transition to 60 mile per hour signs throughout the County.

Moved by Swisher seconded by Zirkelbach to accept a proposal from Grout Scouts, Inc for project number M-0528, a culvert maintenance project on Co Rd E29 in the amount of \$95,117.00. All aye. Motion carried. [2026-096]

The Board gave brief updates on current and past committee meetings.

During the elected official comment period, the Recorder commented on the redaction process for digitized files.
