#### COVID19 FAQs

# Q: Where can I pick up a test kit?

A: Test kits can be picked up at Jones County Public Health Building, 105 Broadway Place Ste 11, Anamosa IA 52205. You can visit www.testiowa.com to find your nearest location as well.

#### Q: What do I do with my completed test kit?

A: Test kits that are ready to be processed can be dropped off at UPS drop off location or taken directly to the State Hygienic Lab in Coralville.

# Q: What is the difference between "isolation" and "quarantine"?

A: <u>Isolation</u> is the practice of staying home when you are sick until you are no longer infectious. <u>Quarantine</u> is the practice of staying away from other people when you have been exposed to someone who is sick even though you still feel well.

# Q: Can schools require isolation for sick students?

A: Yes, schools can require isolations for sick students in accordance with their individual district policies.

### Q: Can schools require quarantine for students who may have been exposed to COVID-19?

A: No, schools do not have the authority to quarantine students without the involvement of a public health agency. (Iowa Code 139A)

### Q: When can I get the booster dose of my COVID-19 vaccine?

A: Booster vaccines are currently only approved for immunocompromised patients and for those 65 years and older and residents in long-term care and only for those who received the Pfizer vaccine. It must be at least 6 months after your primary vaccine series. Boosters are not available or recommended for those who received the Moderna or Johnson & Johnson vaccines.

### Q: Where can I get my boost dose of COVID-19 vaccine?

A: Many primary care providers and pharmacies in Jones County have COVID-19 vaccine in their clinics/pharmacies. You can visit <u>Vaccines.gov</u> and search by location and type of COVID-19 vaccine you need. This site is not specific to booster doses. If you know someone in need of the first or second doses of COVID-19 vaccine, this site can be used as well.

# Q: What if I don't have my COVID-19 vaccination card/record?

A: Visit Iowa's Immunization Registry Information System (IRIS) website.

- The INFORMATION FOR PARENTS/GUARDIANS AND ADULTS section has a RECORD REQUEST FORM. You can complete the form and submit to IRIS.
