Linn County's Mental Health Access Center can help.

The Mental Health Access Center provides care for those experiencing a mental health or substance use disorder crisis that requires immediate attention. Few options for this kind of care exist, but Linn County and our partners in the community saw the need and worked together to create a treatment facility.

It is our goal to quickly assess your situation, provide services to help alleviate your crisis and connect you to community-based services. Meeting this goal will ultimately reduce the number of unnecessary hospitalizations and arrests while creating a healthier community.

Services include:

- Immediate triage and screening
- Suicide assessment and safety planning
- Crisis stabilization and observation
- Subacute services
- Crisis psychiatric evaluations
- Substance abuse assessment and counseling
- Care coordination and referrals

The Access Center will not be able to serve:

- Individuals in need of immediate medical care
- Individuals who are violent at arrival or immediately prior to arrival with a likelihood that they will seriously hurt themselves, other patients, or our employees
- Minors 17 years old or younger

The Mental Health Access Center is open 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.
